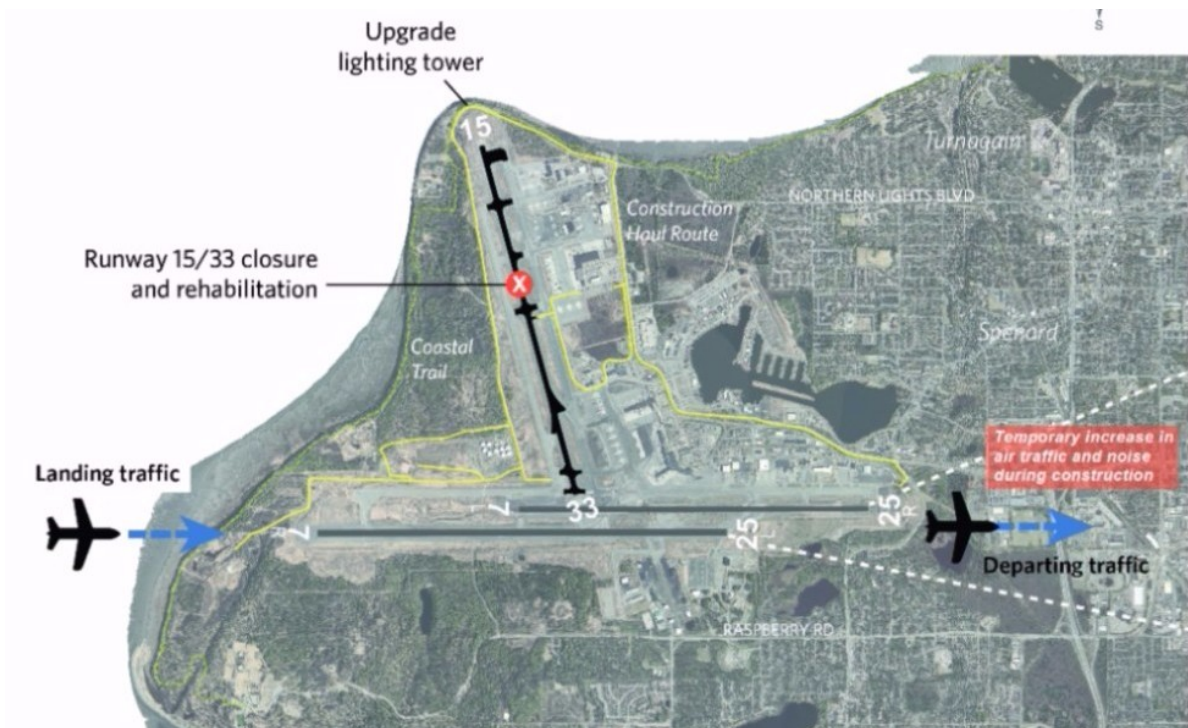

This is a reminder that you are invited attend this Thursday's public meeting to learn more about the ANC Runway 1533 Rehabilitation Project, the proposed improvements, and potential impacts. Project team members will be present to answer questions and provide project

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) recognizes the need to address the poor pavement conditions of runway 15/33 at the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (ANC), and to maintain the safety and efficiency of airport operations.

The project will rehabilitate RW 15/33 (the north/south runway), widen the runway, and update taxiway geometry to meet FAA standards. In addition, RW 15/33's aging pavement will be repaired. All improvements will occur on airport property. In order to complete this work, the 15/33 runway will need to be closed to operations for one or two construction seasons starting in 2018. Air traffic will be shifted to the east-west runways during construction.
