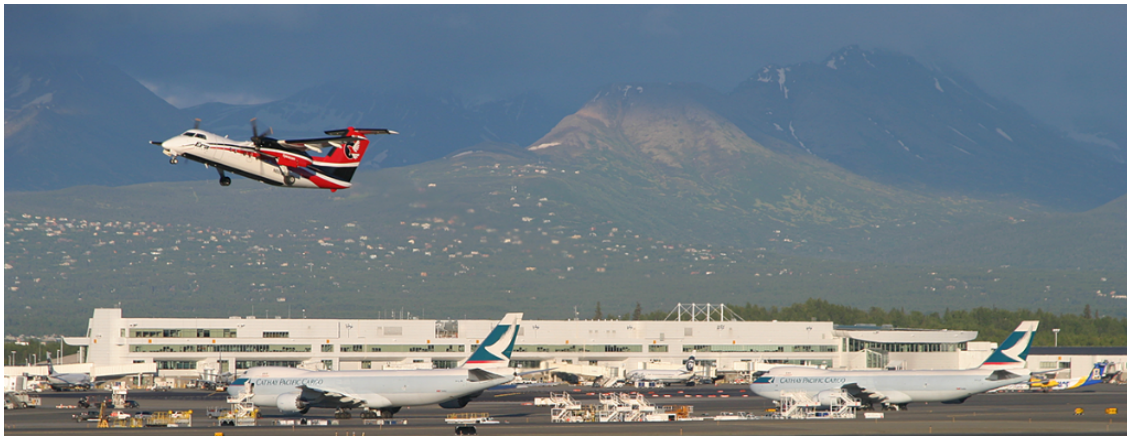

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in cooperation with the Federal Aviation Administration, is soliciting comments on a Draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for a proposed project to address poor pavement conditions of Runway (RW) 15/33 and maintain the safety and efficiency of airport operations at the Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport in Anchorage, Alaska.
